

EU DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (EU) 2025/40

This EU Declaration of Conformity is issued in accordance with Article 39 and Annex VIII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste.

2. Object of the Declaration

The object of this declaration is plastic trays and lids (manufactured in DPET, APET, rPET, OPS, PP and PP Chalk placed on the EU market by Plus Pack A/S as primary food packaging for business-to-business supply.

This declaration applies to all plastic trays and lids manufactured and/or supplied by Plus Pack A/S under its commercial portfolio, provided that the polymer family and mono-material design remain unchanged. This declaration does not cover customer-applied labels, sleeves, sealing films, secondary or tertiary packaging.

3. Declaration of Conformity

Compliance with the requirements laid down in or pursuant to Articles 5 to 12 of the Regulation has been demonstrated, insofar as they are applicable to the packaging concerned. This includes, among others, Article 5 (substances of concern):

- Plus Pack A/S confirms that the plastic packaging covered by this declaration does not intentionally contain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). The packaging complies with the concentration limits established under Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

Compliance is demonstrated and documented within the technical documentation maintained in accordance with Annex VII of the Regulation.

4. Applicable Union Legislation

This declaration concerns compliance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR).

Compliance with food contact legislations (Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004, Regulation (EU) 10/2011, Regulation (EU) 2022/1616, where applicable, etc.) is covered by separate, product specific Declarations of Compliance.

5. Conformity Assessment Procedure

Conformity has been assessed in accordance with Annex VII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 under the internal production control procedure.

The assessment is based on design specifications, supplier documentation, recyclability assessments, recycled content documentation (where applicable), and food contact compliance documentation.

6. Technical Documentation

The technical documentation supporting this declaration is maintained in accordance with Annex VII and made available to competent authorities upon request.


Retention period: Single-use packaging – minimum 5 years.
