Duni declares that the article meets the requirements of:

- Article 3, 11(5), 15 and 17 of Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 (Framework regulation)
- EU Regulation 2023/2006/EC (GMP)
- EU Regulation 10/2011/EC with amendments (Plastic regulation)
- EU Regulation (EU) 2024/3190 on the use of bisphenol A (BPA) and other bisphenols

This plastic product has been manufactured only with monomers, other starting substances and additives that are authorized under Regulation (EC) 10/2011 and all amendments. A risk assessment according to Article 18 and Article 19 of Regulation (EC) No. 10/2011 has been performed for this product.

### Overall migration

The overall migration tests have been performed on representative samples of the product. The overall migration limit 10 mg/dm<sup>2</sup> stipulated in the Commission Regulation (EU) 10/2011 is not exceeded.

### Specific migration

One or more of the substances are subject to specific migration limits. All restricted substances have undergone migration testing, and the results confirm compliance with the applicable limit values.

### Area of use

The boxes can be used safely with all types of foods, serving cold and warm up to 70°C for a maximum of 2 hours. Be aware at temperatures close to 70°C the sturdiness of the plastic is affected and may deform.

The articles can be used for long-term storage in ambient and chilled conditions.

**Microwave use:** The product is not suitable for heating in microwave ovens.

**Freezing:** The items can be used for frozen food, but it is not recommended for storage in the freezer due to material properties.

**Test conditions**

Migration tests on the material of the article performed by an independent institute showed that under the following test conditions overall migration and specific migration fall below the respective limits given by regulation 10/2011.

Ratio of food contact surface area to volume of component used to establish the compliance of material is 6 dm<sup>2</sup>/kg.

The boxes comply with the general restrictions of Regulation (EC) No. 10/2011 Annex 2 regarding heavy metals and PAA content.

According to raw material suppliers the material may contain one or more dual use additives (i.e. food additives or flavorings according to Regulation (EC) No 1333/2008) subject to restrictions or specifications under Article 11.3 in EU Regulation 10/2011/EC (Plastic regulation).
